Monday October 9th	FOCUS QUESTION Who are the members of the CSI Team, and what is their job?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will receive notes on members of the CSI Team, mug shots, police line-ups. We will discuss who is part of the CSI Team and what job they do. Tuesday October 10th	FOCUS QUESTION Why can police line-ups be unreliable? What makes a fair line-up?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will share how difficult it was to identify the suspect from the video they watched yesterday and realize that identifying a person in a police line-up would be very challenging. Students will learn the characteristics of a fair police line-up Students will make a mug shot of themselves use a computer program. http://pimptheface.com/create/ 	HW: None Students will to explain the reason police line-ups are unreliable is that witness don't always remember all the details to recognize the correct person. A fair line-up the members will all have similar physical characteristics.
Wednesday October 11th	FOCUS QUESTION Why is it important to work together as a team? Fire Drill at 1:55 p.m. (7th Hour)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will try to match their classmates with the mug shot they made of themselves. Students will learn to work together by participating in team building activities (Reverse Line-Up in a Chair Cup Pyramid, Wooden Feet - Raging River) 	HW: None Students will be able to express that when they work together they are more successful in completing a task.
Thursday October 12th	FOCUS QUESTION Why is it important to listen to the ideas of every team member?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will work together in small groups to follow a series of picture clues that are concealed in an envelope and opened one at a time. 	HW: None Students will be able to share stories of frustration when they had the right answer, but no one listened to them. So they got lost.
